1. Identify stakeholders, users early on and get involvement throughout project
2. Sticky exercise of post it notes doing a round table of all stakeholders – each discussing their requirements. Sort into common groups. Identify who gave the requirements. Trade requirements through project and what solution was
3. Swim lane chart for cross functional
4. Use cases flush out requirements
5. Agile early prototyping flush out requirements
